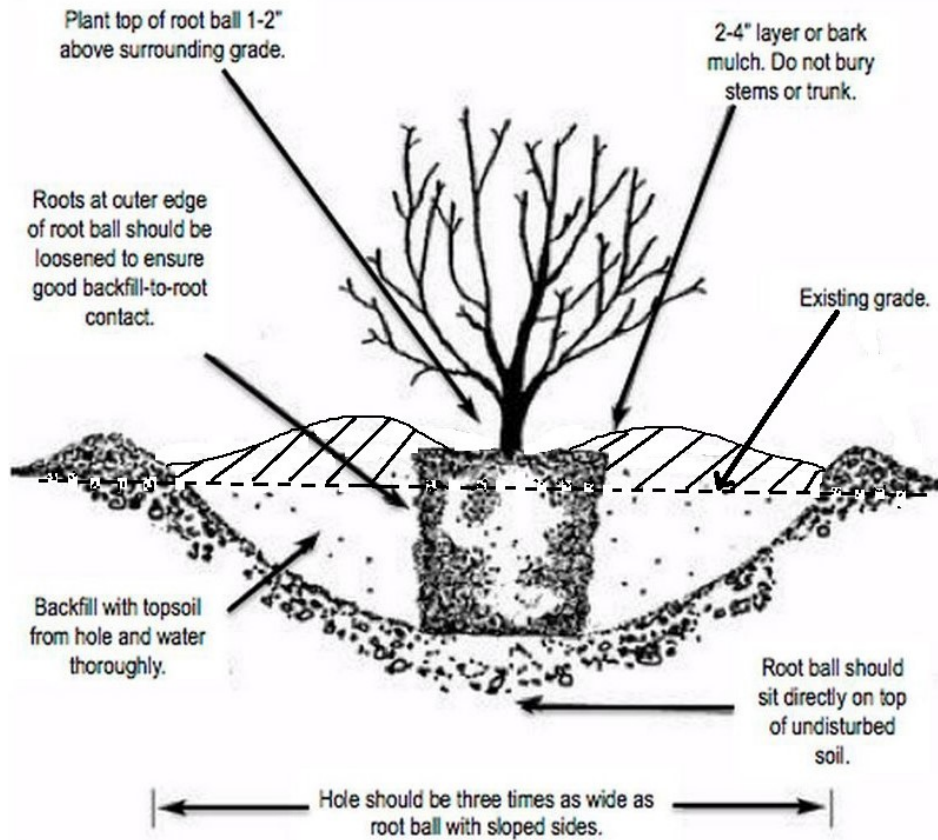


## PLANTING & WATERING GUIDELINES



**"Plant it high—it will never die. Plant it low—it will never grow!"**

Winter watering deciduous and evergreens: Test soil moisture 2" below surface, if dry, water when temp. is above 40°, preferably in the morning. Depending on precipitation, plan on watering 2x a month when newly planted trees are dormant. Resume normal water schedule when deciduous trees break dormancy in spring.

\*Note: the top of the root ball is not buried with backfill\*

## GUARANTEE FOR TREES & SHRUBS

If you follow the recommendations for planting and care, and your plant declines within the growing season of purchase, please contact us via email with a description of the problem. While we do not have a 100% return/refund policy, we can typically exchange for equal value. For plants that fail to overwinter we typically do not offer exchanges or refunds unless we are made aware of the declining health in the 5+ months of warmer months after purchase.

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## CHOOSE THE RIGHT PLANT

It is important to pick the right tree or shrub for your planting site. Take note of how much sun exposure and moisture your planting site gets and make sure the tree or shrub you select fits these conditions.
